1948

1948 saw the first football season played in the newly formed W.N.Y. Catholic league. Eight schools participated in the inaugural season. St. Josephs, St. Francis, Canisius, Bishop Timon, Bishop Duffy of Niagara Falls, Bishop Ryan, Lockport DeSales and St. Mary's in Dunkirk. However, St. Mary's failed to finish the season, forfeiting their last three games. The league's first "Star" was halfback Stan Tubinis from Bishop Duffy. He easily won the scoring title, once scoring four touchdowns in one game. (vs St. Mary's Dunkirk). St. Josephs and Canisius emerged as Co-Champions. This year saw the resumption of the St. Josephs vs Canisius rivalry, started in 1921 but dormant since 1931, a span of seventeen years.
