# Canisius High School



With the return of a traditional season for the 2021-22 campaign, the Crusaders were more than eager to get back on the court in pursuit of the school's 19<sup>th</sup> Manhattan Cup. The team of 13 players is working hard to improve every day with the goal of bringing the Cup back to Delaware Ave.

Canisius is led by the dynamic duo of 6'7 senior Declan Ryan and 6'4 junior Shane Cercone. Both players are effective inside and out as each can finish at the rim and connect on shots from the perimeter. Despite being the focal point of opposing game plans, Declan is averaging 21.6 pts & 9.5 rebounds per game while Shane averages 20.3 pts & 9 rebounds. On the defensive end, Shane is routinely matched up against one of the opponent's best players while Declan is an imposing presence at the rim. Declan has garnered Division I interest and plans to attend Wooster Academy in the fall. Shane, who recently surpassed 1,000 career points, has received scholarship offers

from the University at Albany and Fairfield University with that list sure to grow soon.

Junior Luke Grant along with seniors Connor Schuster and Eddie Cosgrove round out the starting five and provide the perfect complement to Shane and Declan. Luke is great at getting the ball where it needs to be, can score on all three levels, and is always a calming presence on the court. Connor has provided outstanding senior leadership while being a great defender and knocking down 3-pointers when called upon. Eddie is a very good shooter and also averages 5.5 rebounds a game. Senior Vinny Conroy has given the team great minutes playing the ever-important role of 6<sup>th</sup> man and always seems to be in the right spot for a big rebound or loose ball. Sophomore Pat Benzer's minutes have increased as the season has gone on and the smooth-shooting big man continues to improve on both ends of the court.

The Crusaders have played a very competitive schedule against schools from 6 different states with the hope of growing as a team to prepare for the challenges that await in the Manhattan Cup playoffs.

The Hawks remain the defending NYSCHSAA Class B champions and will depend heavily on this year's Senior Class of Keiyan Clarke, Jacob Kanowski, Chris Wright and Brandon Threet. All 4 Seniors have at least 3 years of experience in the program and bring the GOLD MENTALITY to the team.

Chris Wright is a returning All-Catholic selection and has led the team in all statistical categories the past two seasons. Keiyan Clarke and Jacob Kanowski are the team's best shooters from 3PT and FT, as well as the primary ball handlers. Brandon Threet, an All-Catholic Football selection, brings toughness to the Hawks with his defense and rebounding, as well making second effort plays. No one takes more charges or dives for more loose balls on the team.

The Hawks Underclassmen are a talented group that will be expected to contribute immediately. The Junior Class consists of Michael Ross, Enadio Wani, and Isaih Serrano. Ross, an All-Catholic Football selection, rounds out the starting 5 and is known for being a defensive stopper and 3PT threat. Wani and Serrano can both score and defend the other teams top point guard. The Sophomore Class features Austin Whiteman, Simmarion Threet, and Josh Ogiba. Whiteman can play inside-out, rebounds well and can knock down the 3. Simmarion Threet, another All-Catholic Football selection, is one of the teams best defenders and rebounders from the guard position. Josh Ogiba, playing his first season of Varsity Basketball, continues his improvement and looks to contribute to the Hawks' success down the stretch.

The Red Raiders also faced off against the top ranked local schools including McKinley, Tapestry, Williamsville East, and Health Sciences Charter as well as 2 of the top schools from Rochester; McQuaid and Aquinas. Add these games to the ultra-competitive MMHSAA schedule and the Red Raiders featured one of the toughest schedules in WNY. At press time the Red Raiders currently stood with a record of 12-7 and a 4-4 league record, good enough for a top 5 ranking in WNY by the Buffalo News. Highlights of the non-league schedule includes road non-league wins over top ranked opponents at McKinley and Christian Brothers Academy. The Red Raiders also earned home victories over McQuaid (Rochester) and tournament wins over Williamsville East and the then number ranked Health Sciences Charter School that earned them the championship of the Live Like

Luca Holiday Tournament hosted by St. Francis. In league play the Red Raiders currently hold victories over Nichols, St. Mary's of Lancaster and a season sweep of Cardinal O'Hara. The Red Raiders have come up short in close loses against league rivals St. Joseph's and Timon.

The Red Raiders have had a well balanced offensive attack all season, consistently getting contributions from 8 players. The Red Raiders boost a lineup that includes 3 players measuring 6'5' or better. Leading the way offensively has been senior captain and 3-year varsity player forward Brendan Reid. Brendan is averaging 13.3 points and 10 rebounds per game. Junior forward Logan Reaska is right behind Reid averaging 13 points and 8 rebounds a game. Both players provide a match up problem for opposing defenses as both can play both inside and on the perimeter. Senior captain CJ Moore has maned the point guard position this season and has chipped in nearly 10 points per game to go along with a 2 to 1 assist to turnover ratio. Junior slasher Sammy Marry leads the team on the defensive end routinely guarding the opponent's best player while also scoring 10 points a game on the offensive end. Sophomore center Marcus Harrison controls the paint for the Red Raiders, measuring in at 6'8". Off the bench the Red Raiders have been led by senior guard/forward Darnell Dallas who has played nearly every position on the floor, and sophomore guards Jeremiah Neely and Nick Bienko. The St. Francis Red Raiders basketball team with the support of the St. Francis staff, students, fans, and alumni look to get back to the finals and bring the Manhattan Cup back to the halls of St. Francis High School.

Sam Knopse adds more size to the interior and plays well in the low post. The Lancers are a force to be reckoned with when firing on all cylinders.

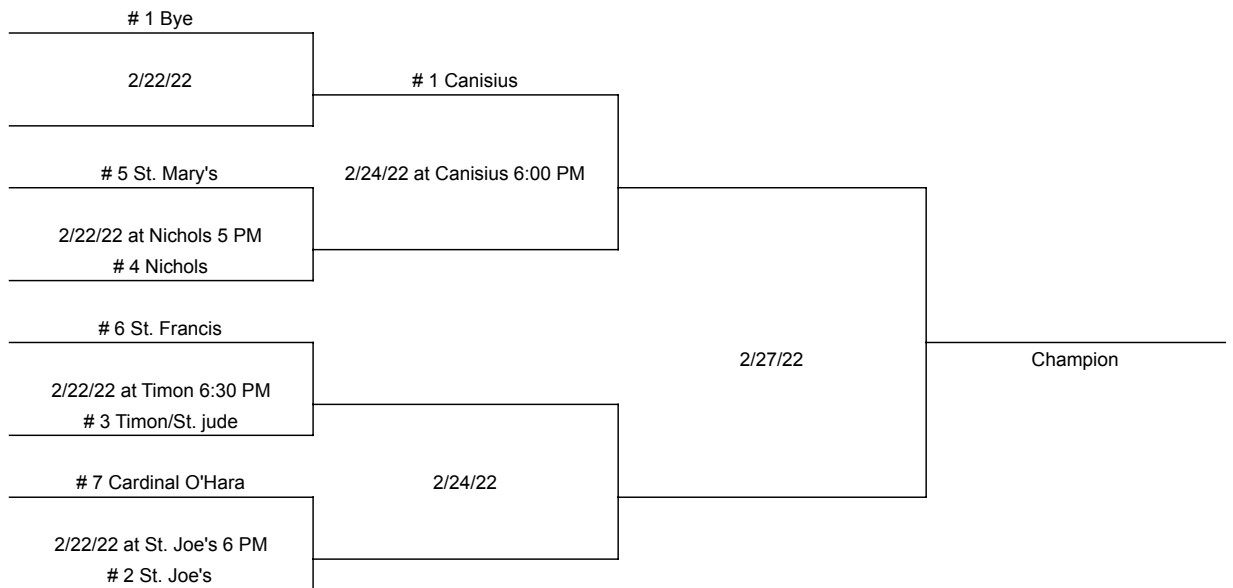
